

Road crashes are the primary cause of death and disability for young people globally

William Shakespeare wrote in his Winter's Tale,



"I wish that there were no age between sixteen and twenty three, or that youth would sleep during that time, for all they do is getting girls pregnant, harass the old, steal and fight"

It is true that,



The young are, very often, reckless!

But youth is the future of mankind and it is the utmost duty of society to protect the young

It is also true that,



The young, especially juveniles,

do not like to be told what to do and what not to do!

We, in Cyprus, are convinced that,

The way to tackle the problem, is to get the youth actively involved in the road safety efforts



Our motto is that,

"Youth is not part of the problem, it is part of the solution of the problem"

As Floor Lieshout, President of YOURS, said

"Young people are engines for change, but they need to be taken seriously and for that, they need to be well informed"

4rth European Road Safety Day

25 July 2012, Nicosia, Cyprus

"Active involvement of Youth in Road Safety".

The event was ...

...co-organized by the Cyprus EU Presidency and the European Commission and was strongly supported by YOURS and the Cypriot youth organization REACTION

In the conference,

Youth road safety workers from the EU member states and neighbouring regions, scientists and road safety officials and experts, shared their knowledge, experience and ideas, through the excellent presentations and the animated debates in the workshops







A series of invaluable conclusions were drawn. The most important were:



The best way to raise road safety awareness among the young, is through a peer-to-peer interactive approach

(by trained and skilled young educators, who speak the same language and understand the young)



A culture of "Safe is Cool"

should be created among the young



Governments should invest money in providing safe transport options to the young



Equal focus should be given by the police to checking for drug driving and drink driving

The message should be clear:

There is <u>no</u> safe maximum for drink or drugs behind the wheel!



Effective enforcement of rules and raising of road safety awareness should complement each other



Provide young bikers
with training
by experts
(role models)
for safe riding



Young bikers should be taught to think beyond the rules



The young should be convinced that distracted driving kills



Young women should be empowered *to say no*





Young women should also be convinced not to reward reckless driving



Parents are role models to their children and they should be encouraged to give the right example in safe driving and safe road behaviour in general



Parents should provide driver training and driving experience to their children

A graduated driving licence system is most appropriate.

Alternatively, some restrictions for novice drivers may be enforced

- Police and youth organizations should cooperate in raising road safety awareness of the young and in the design of enforcement activities targeting the young
- Youth organizations should be encouraged and empowered to support enforcement activities, with their own parallel awareness raising activities



Through the cooperation between the police and youth organizations, the young should be convinced that enforcement aims to save lives

Finally, the most important conclusion was,



Society should work together with youth for the road safety of the young
